## Minutes APPD Business Meeting, April 15, 2018 Montreal, Canada

- Dayle Benson gave the Treasurer's Report. She noted that the reserves look good. She also suggested that some of the reserves may need to be invested into a program to recruit new members. The Treasurer's Report was approved.
- Ivy Baer reported that the Spring APPAD meeting in New Orleans went well. Several APPD members noted that their APPAD members told them that some in APPAD believe that APPD has directed that the APPAD meeting sessions should remain in silos (patient accounting, revenue cycle, and managed care) and also that individuals without APPD members cannot attend. Ivy responded that AAMC staff has suggested ways to lessen the time spent at break-outs at the APPAD meeting and increase time that everyone spends together as the groups often discuss similar issues, but APPAD members have resisted. She also noted that individuals who want to attend the meeting are welcome, even if they do not have an APPD members. She reminded the group that, as directed by APPD, there is a separate registration fee for individuals who do not have an APPD members are aware of this information.

  - Paul Newman and Jeff Wasserman volunteered to plan

    - How are people structuring their organization for at risk/value based medicine? MSSP...are you going to stay in the program? What is the role of the practice plan?
    - Population health reporting data, dashboards, etc.
    - Support staff benchmarking standards
    - APPs and productivity targets/time allocation? Beth's/Penn model
    - Telehealth what are people are doing?
    - Things to implement to manage under rate setting state price vs utilization
    - Consumerism.....what are people doing...how are they positioning their organizations
    - What are people doing about CINs.....gainsharing may not be worth it.
- Anthony Masciotra gave the Credentials Committee report as Carlos Rosende, Chair, was unable to attend. Carlos will step down as Chair at the Fall Meeting. Paul Hudson become chair. Laurie Norwick will join the Committee
- Stacia Gueriguian discussed possible sites for the Spring and Fall 2019 Meetings. The following sites will be explored:

  - Fall: Aspen, Laguna Nigel, Portland, ME
